

Dear Parents,

Thank you for considering St. Mary's Episcopal Day School for your child's Kindergarten experience. We know you have other options for Kindergarten and we are happy you're choosing to enroll your child at St. Mary's. St. Mary's has been providing quality education in a Christian environment to students and families in the Austin County area since 1964. Our students range in age from eighteen months to six years old. We are accredited by the Southwestern Association of Episcopal Schools and are committed to teaching all students, regardless of race, color, creed, or country of national origin.

We are proud of our Kindergarten program and believe its smaller class size allows us to do fun and unique activities and field trips. This past year our kindergartners took field trips to Little Beakers and Main Street Theater. They visited local businesses, such as First National Bank, the Bellville Courthouse and Judge Leedy, City Hall, the Police Station, the Post Office, Dr. Luekenga's dental office, and the public library.

This year our Kindergarten students are using Saxon Phonics, Go Math and Texas Studies Weekly for Science, Social Studies, Health and Citizenship. On their short days, Kindergartners have whole class instruction with phonics, reading and math. On their long days students have PE, small group center time, weekly trips to the library and special project time. Wednesday afternoons are STEM days where students explore color mixing, chemical reactions, volcanos and various taste testing to name a few. This year they engineered, built and created projects to encourage higher level thinking. Kindergarten students stay until 12:00 on Monday and Friday, and 3:00 on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. They can stay until 3:00 on Monday and Friday or as late as 5:30 any day through our school's enrichment time program.

St. Mary's is blessed to offer additional unique whole school experiences such as weekly Chapel and Bible Time, Spanish, Motor and Tech Labs, Music and Art. During the year we also had Trunk or Treat, visits from local firemen and a dentist, Fair Day with a Kindergarten Shoebox Float parade, a Christmas program, Thanksgiving Feast and Valentine's Day celebrations, Farm Day, Rodeo Day, Space Day, Zoo Day, Ocean Day, an Easter Egg Hunt, an end of year trip to Splashway and Kindergarten graduation.

To reserve a spot for the 2023-2024 Kindergarten class for your child, we will need to have the following:

- 1. Completed Admission Information form
- 2. Completed Binding Contractual Agreement
- 3. Nonrefundable Registration Fee, \$200 for new students, \$150 for returning students
- 4. A nonrefundable supply fee of \$85 which covers class and school supplies, a chapel shirt and yearbook

In addition to the above, we must also have the following to complete your child's school file prior to the first day of school:

- 5. Copy of Current Immunizations (must be updated and signed or stamped by the doctor's office).
- 6. Statement of Health/Physicians Statement, if we do not already have one with the doctor's signature.

TUITION ASSISTANCE
